

Make A Difference MINISTRIES MUSKEGON, MI

3 programs M.A.D. Ministries oversees:

1) **M.A.D. HOUSE** stands for "MAKE A DIFFERENCE" and is a ministry to High School Students. M.A.D. House meets 2 times per month in large group outreach productions that involves 120-150 Students & 25 Adult Staff. On the alternate 2 weeks of each month, M.A.D. House meets with 30 students & 25 Adult staff for relationship building activities and Bible Studies. Other things connected with the high school ministry are trips, retreats, campus meetings, concerts, appointments with students and other outings and events.


2) **M.A.D. IN THE MIDDLE** also stands for "MAKING A DIFFERENCE" to Middle School Students. M.A.D. in the Middle is a New Ministry started this year and is currently meeting 2 times per month. The activities are similar to the High School program, but designed for Middle Schoolers

3) **M.A.D. GRADS** is a "MAKE A DIFFERENCE" ministry to college age people. Some of the M.A.D. House volunteer leaders designed it as a ministry to students who graduated and stayed in Muskegon desiring something to continue their growth in their walk with God. and helping them in career paths.

MAKE A DIFFERENCE Ministries are designed to minister using the following steps

- ... **REACH** out to Local Teens
- ... **CONNECT** them with positive relationships.
- ... **INTRODUCE** them to God.
- ... **grow** them in their faith in God
- ... **DISCOVER** Gods purpose for their life.

AT THE DISCOVERY LEVEL (INVOLVING CORE & STUDENT LEADERS), STUDENTS ARE TAUGHT ABOUT THINGS LIKE SELF WORTH, SERVING OTHERS, CHURCH, PERSONAL TIME WITH GOD, TITHING (GIVING BACK) AND FELLOWSHIP (COMMUNITY).




EXAMPLES:

- * Grow + Core Teen = A Growth Group like a Bible Study

Events

Make A Difference Ministries runs a 2 hour large group production every other Thursday evening that involves 120-170 students and staff. And on the alternate Thursdays, a group that we call the CORE.

C.O.R.E. (Connecting, Overcoming, Renewing, Enduring) involves 30-35 Students that want to know more about God and get extra help with every day issues. They are also involved in helping with the large group production. They meet on the alternate Thursdays of M.A.D. House.
